AWARDS INFORMATION SHEET

Anticipated Release Date – Wednesday, August 9, 2017

An updated Diagnosis module will soon be deployed in your AWARDS database. This document contains important information on the new features, and what to expect when the new module is deployed.

BENEFITS OF THE REVAMP

The new Diagnosis module will give users the following benefits:

- The new index style will be in place, for an improved user experience. Filters, breadcrumbs, links to reports and an action bar will be present.
- Diagnosis records will better reflect current healthcare standards, as only records of the following types will display on the Diagnoses index page, client face sheets and dynamic sections:
 - DSM-V – with an ICD-10 code set
 - "Other" (if currently set to display) – with an ICD-10 code set
 - Disabilities
- A new "Legacy Diagnosis ReportBuilder" will be available, for users to access historical diagnosis records including DSM-IV (all Axes) and ICD-9 records.
- A streamlined data entry page with the following fields.
 - Diagnosis Date*
 - Condition*
 - ICD-10 Code*
 - [Program Name] Order Level
 - Diagnosed By
 - Onset Date
 - End Date (formerly Resolution Date)
 - Comments

PREPARATION TIPS

As previously communicated, in preparation for the Diagnosis update, codes that are not yet moved into ICD-10 should be reviewed prior to the deployment for a seamless transition. Specifically, the following actions are recommended:

- Update any ICD-9 or DSM-IV records to the equivalent ICD-10 if they should be carried forward.
- Enter Resolution Dates on any outstanding DSM-IV and ICD-9 records that should be archived/no longer in effect.

For agencies with access to the ImportTool feature, the Diagnosis ImportTool has been updated to allow you to update these records in a batch. The tool can be used to insert Resolution Dates where needed and create new ICD-10 records. The "Foothold Report – Diagnosis Audit without Disabilities" saved format in the Diagnosis ReportBuilder can assist in gathering the information needed for the import file, or as an audit to see which records need updating.

Once this update is deployed, any DSM-IV and ICD-9 records will only be available in reports.

DATA ENTRY PREVIEW

Here is a preview of the new Diagnoses data entry screen. This agency is set up to use the IMO feature, resulting in the Condition and ICD-10 Code fields being pre-populated with information selected in the IMO window.

For programs capturing Disability information, the Condition field will now be used to save the specific disability (as either a text box or using the IMO add-on feature).
